

How to Protect Cacti & Succulents from Frost

-NEVER water directly before a freeze! Most succulents survive freezing temperatures if their soil is kept DRY!

-Columnar cacti are most vulnerable to damage at the top. These can be covered with red solo cup.

-If in containers and you are able to bring them inside to protect them than do so prior to freeze.

-To further protect outdoor succulents and cacti, you can wrap with Christmas lights and cover with frost cloth *(see our frost prep video for more.)*

-Frost damaged succulents and cacti usually appear almost white and will frequently turn black and wilt.

-Wait to do any pruning until danger of frost has passed.
