

# HOYA CARE

## *instructions*



Allow plant to dry out in between waterings. Certain varieties require more frequent waterings than others. Signs of underwatering, thin or puckered leaves. Common mistake is overwatering.



Bright light, avoid direct sunlight. Commonly understory plants in the wild, like Philodendrons and Orchids.



Moderately warm environment. Thrive in 40-50% humidity. Prefer to be slightly root bound. Choose a loose well draining potting medium. Grow well outside in containers under covering, bring indoors in 50F and below.



Fertilize with orchid food to encourage blooms. Fertilize 1-2x a month with Microlife Super Seaweed or MicroLife Ocean Harvest.



Common pests include spider mites and mealybugs. Watering regularly can help prevent this.
