

PEPEROMIA CARE

instructions



Bottom water with saucer, or water soil directly. Avoid excess moisture on foliage, treat similar to a succulent. Common mistake is overwatering.



Peperomia require bright light (filtered through a window.) If you notice long (stretched) stems, your plant wants brighter light. Common mistake placing in low light.



Moderately warm environment. Thrive in 40-50% humidity. Shallow roots, choose pot that is no more than an inch or two larger than nursery pot. Does well in terrarium (non-fuzzy varieties).



Fertilize during growing season 1-2x a month with MicroLife Super Seaweed or MicroLife Ocean Harvest.



Possible pests include spider mites and thrips. Watering regularly can help prevent this.
