

M Water thoroughly once soil has completely dried out.

Philodendrons require bright to bright indirect light (filtered through a window.) If leaves appear bleached, it is receiving too much light.

Moderately warm environment. Thrive in 40-50% humidity. Be careful to not grow in too large of a container. Prefer to be a little tighter.

Fertilize every other watering during growing season. We recommend MicroLife Super Seaweed, MicroLife Ocean Harvest. If leaves appear pale or washed out in color, try feeding!



Common pests include spider mites and thrips. Watering regularly can help prevent this.
